Cryopreservation or vitrification and subsequent successful recovery of viable cells has been a reality for decades. This ability has sparked the field of cryonics, which proposes to extend human life by cryopreservation of a person until such time as their cause of death can be reversed. Dr. Krieger will present the basic and not-so-basic factors impacting successful cryopreservation of sperm and consider the impact of these factors on the potential for successful cryopreservation of tissues and organs.
